(+ Compulsory Membership, Admin Fee, Jump Levy & Camping if applicable).

until all applicable fees are paid **

The Kapunda Show Society is affiliated with EA (SA Branch), Show Horse Council of SA, Agricultural Societies Council of SA and the Northern Agricultural Shows Association of SA Inc.

1. All relevant registration papers must be produced if required
2. Random swabbing may be conducted throughout the show by the EA
3. Protests lodged must be lodged with the Secretary with the fee of \$50 within 30 minutes of completion of event. This will be refunded if protest upheld. The Committee's decision is final and no further correspondence will be entered into: Dispute Committee: President, Secretary, Judge, Convenor + Committee Member
4. Exhibitors must be current financial members of the Kapunda & Light Agricultural Society Inc. All stock must be registered or recorded with their respective organisations (where applicable)
5. The Show Society reserve the right to combine any event with less than 4 entries
6. The Show Society reserves the right to cancel, alter or change any event at its discretion
7. The Show Society reserve the right to remove any exhibitor from the grounds for improper conduct
8. The Judge's decision is final on the day
9. All ages are ages of riders on the day of competition
10. All riders must wear APPROVED Helmets & Boots whilst mounted on their horses.

11. **HORSE COMPETITORS ARE REQUIRED TO TIE UP HORSES AT ALL TIMES WHEN UNATTENDED. THIS REQUEST IS TO BE STRICTLY ADHERED TO AND IS A CONDITION OF ENTRY TO THE GROUNDS.**
12. **Riding of Horses on Trotting Track is prohibited, other than designated crossings/entry points to rings**
13. **Vehicles on Trotting Track are NOT permitted**
14. Day & Campers Parking must be orderly
15. Competitors are asked to **strictly** adhere to areas that have been either roped off or marked "**NO PARKING**". **This is also a condition of entry.**
16. Camping Fee: \$20.00 – all unpowered sites.
17. Please leave your Parking Space in a clean and tidy condition. Straw & Manure to be left heaped for pickup and string to be placed in the Rubbish Bins provided
18. **Dogs must be on a leash AT ALL TIMES**- Failure to do so will result in removal from grounds without refund
19. No Horses in the Entertainment Complex
20. No tying horses or yards to any permanent fixtures, e.g. power boxes or outside fence.
21. Prize money and any accompanying awards i.e., bags of chaff, vouchers, will be forfeited if not collected before December 2023.
22. The Committee reserves the right to cancel, alter or change any event at its discretion.
23. Refunds; ***Entry Fee (not Membership or Administration/Ground Fee) will be refunded and ONLY IF A Veterinary Certificate or Doctor's Certificate is produced. No correspondence will be entered into.***

**** Riding of Horses on Trotting Track is prohibited – other than designated crossings/entry points to rings ****

**** Day Parking permitted on ambulance track with horses to be tied up on the oval****

- All Jumping classes are to be conducted under the EA National Jumping Rules
- All horses participating in classes 1.05m and above are required to be registered with EA and hold a current Competition Licence.
- All riders competing 1.04m and below must be minimum EA participant members. All riders competing 1.05 and above must be EA Competitive members.
- Competition Licences will be required to be produced on request.
- Junior riders may compete in both Junior and Open classes on the same horse.

Competitors must enter at least 1 class of 50cm or over in at least 2 of the 3 Northern Agricultural Shows (Burra, Kapunda & Eudunda)

The 'Rider' with the highest Showjumping Aggregate points at the completion of the Eudunda Show will be the Winner.

Nomination to be clearly shown on HIA entry form/Nominate form in a box marked NTS (Northern Triangle Showjumping)

Riders must nominate at the show they are competing at, to be eligible for the final prize.

The Winner to be awarded at the Eudunda Show on November 12th 2023

Riders must enter heights of 50 cm or above with the best results from a maximum 2 events at each show counting towards the NTS competition

Rescue Relay isn't applicable for this competition.

Point system for Northern Triangle Showjumping Competition

1 Point for each class entered (2 maximum)

1 Point for each clear round

5 Points for 1st Place

3 Points for 2nd Place

1 Point for 3rd Place

All Showjumping results are to be scanned and sent to the secretary of the Eudunda Show to be used if a count back is required to determine the Winner
