OJD Policy for Sheep Sections at all SA Country Shows.

Entries will only be accepted from exhibitors who can provide a National Sheep Health Statement (SHS) which states that the flock is in the Sheep Market Assurance Program (Sheep MAP) and/or can provide proof that the animals to be exhibited are approved vaccinates (as defined in the explanatory notes of the SHS).

At the time of entry exhibitors must provide

- ◆ An entry form and KLAS membership form
- ◆ A completed NVD & National SHS and/or an approved vaccination declaration
- ◆ Stud Number and organization name
- ◆ OJD Map Status and Brucellosis number

Stock transport must be parked in the car park.

ALL SHEEP TO BE PENNED BY 8:30 A.M. Judging begins as 10:00am.

Champion Presentation at 2:30pm. No stock to be removed until 3:30pm.

Arrival and camping on the Friday 28 October is available at a cost of \$15 per breeder.

All entrants are responsible for providing and removing own bedding, straw and hay.

A trailer will be provided where waste & bedding can be disposed.

A pen of three ewes; 2021 drop.

Please provide month of birth and breed as classes may be divided further if entries allow.
